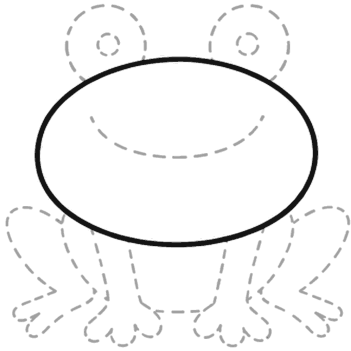


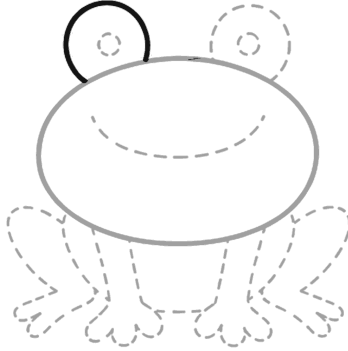
How to Draw a Frog

You need: a pencil, an eraser, black crayons or a black pen, paper

1. Draw the big head



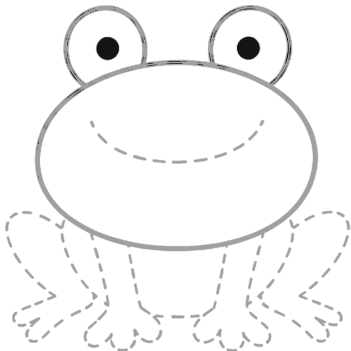
2. Add the left eye



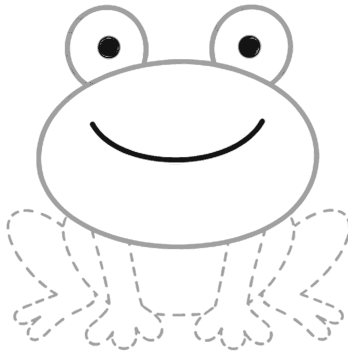
3. Add the right eye



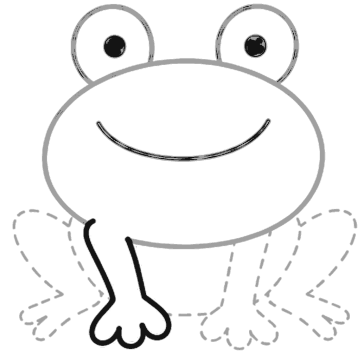
4. Draw the pupils



5. Draw the smile



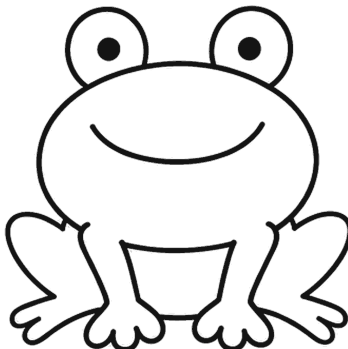
6. Draw the left front leg



7. Draw the right front leg



8. Finish and rub out guides



How to Draw a Frog

1. Draw the big head

Draw one wide oval in the middle for the frog's big head and body.

2. Add the left eye

Draw a round eye bump on the top left of the oval. Let the bottom of the circle tuck into the head.

3. Add the right eye

Draw the matching round eye bump on the top right side. Keep it about the same size as the first eye.

4. Draw the pupils

Draw a small filled circle inside each eye for the pupils.

5. Draw the smile

Draw a wide curved smile across the middle of the face. Curve it up at both ends.

6. Draw the left front leg

Draw the front leg on the left. Start under the body, bring the line down, and finish with a three-toed foot.

7. Draw the right front leg

Draw the matching front leg on the right with another three-toed foot. Keep the middle gap open between the legs.

8. Finish and rub out guides

Go over the head, eyes, smile, side legs, and toes you are keeping. Then rub out all the pale dotted guide lines.

Tips

- Draw the first shapes lightly so they are easy to rub out.
- Keep the two eyes and the two front feet about the same size.
- Round toes make the frog look soft and friendly.
